
A Trip Worth Remembering

It was an 8-day exclusive family trip, which included my birthday too.

We landed at Siliguri airport and went to Gangtok, which is around 105 km away and is the capital of Sikkim.

The most amazing thing was the clean roads there, and we were told that Sikkim is an organic state and had also received a cleanliness award.



24 March 2023

The next morning we started our day with a visit to Echey Monastery (a solitary monastery). The viewpoint monastery was so beautiful inside out, and it had different scriptures. Then we went on a ropeway where we could see the city of Gangtok. We then went to a flower garden followed by Hanuman Tok, where it is believed that Lord Hanuman took rest for a moment when he was on his way to Lanka from the Himalayas and was carrying Sanjeevani herbs to cure Lakshman. The Banjhakri Falls are so beautiful and it was relaxing too.

25 March 2023

On the way to Lechen, a town in Sikkim, we visited the calm and peaceful Butterfly waterfalls and it reminded me of a quote: "Just go with the flow". I also came to know that the main rivers of Sikkim are Krista and Rangeeth, and their state animal is the red panda. We enjoyed the traditional food here - Dal Bhat, and momos, or dumplings - influenced by Nepalese cuisine.

26 March 2023

Our next location was Kalaptther (Black Stones), which is known for its breathtaking views of the snow-clad mountains and mesmerizing landscapes providing the most accessible close-up view of the Everest. The next stop was Gurudongmar Lake, which is one of the highest lakes in the world and in India. It is located at an altitude of 5425m (17800 ft) and is considered holy by both Sikhs and Buddhists. The most shocking thing is that it is located in the peak of mountains, but never freezes even in the winter season.



Bharat is the world's fifth-largest economy and has stopped its journey towards development. Recently, Bharat got the chance to host the G20 summit, and at this summit, Bharat planned a "new economic corridor". It is named the India-Middle East European Corridor [IMEC]. Before this, Asian and European countries used the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC). Countries use this corridor to transport goods across the globe. Countries used to pay high transportation costs to China and Pakistan. The reason behind planning this new corridor is to transport goods at a low cost and to cut trade time. [CPEC] is a sea- and land-based corridor, but Bharat uses land, railways, and seaways to transport goods. To boost this, the Global Biofuel Alliance is made up of the members of the G20 summit. On September 10, 2023, the Memorandum of Understanding [MoU] was signed.


own innovations. As the management club of Gatik, emphasize that management is apart of everyone's life in every way possible and we work to develop that aspect of our daily lives.



Literary Club Tanvi




